



Teaching and Research Positions, Chiropractic Department, University of Zürich

Call for Applications

We are pleased to invite applications from suitably qualified individuals to assist in both teaching and research in the Chiropractic Department, Faculty of Medicine, the University of Zürich, Switzerland.

The chiropractic curriculum is a 6-year program consisting of a 3-year Bachelor of Medicine cycle followed by the 3-year Master of Chiropractic Medicine degree. The first cohort of students started the chiropractic program in September, 2008 and the second cohort will begin in September 2009. The chiropractic curriculum will be taught in German and English.

With increasing student enrolment, there is a need for suitably qualified and experienced chiropractors to assist in teaching chiropractic assessment, diagnosis and technique. In addition, applicants must be interested and willing to assist in research projects within the Chiropractic Department.

Applicants should have 5-years of independent practice that is patient-centred and evidence-based. Previous teaching experience is essential. Experience teaching in a chiropractic institution accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE) or European Council on Chiropractic Education (ECCE) is preferred. Other teaching experience in an institution of higher learning or Postgraduate Chiropractic education programs will be considered. Research experience is also highly desirable. Applicants must be fluent in German and English and must be eligible to practice Chiropractic in Switzerland.

Successful applicants will undergo a brief orientation and training program. A minimum commitment of 1 year is required for these positions. At the end of 1-year, all individuals will undergo a review of teaching and research performance.

All interested individuals are requested to submit their current curriculum vitae (CV) along with a letter of intent outlining reasons for applying and further evidence supporting their application.
