

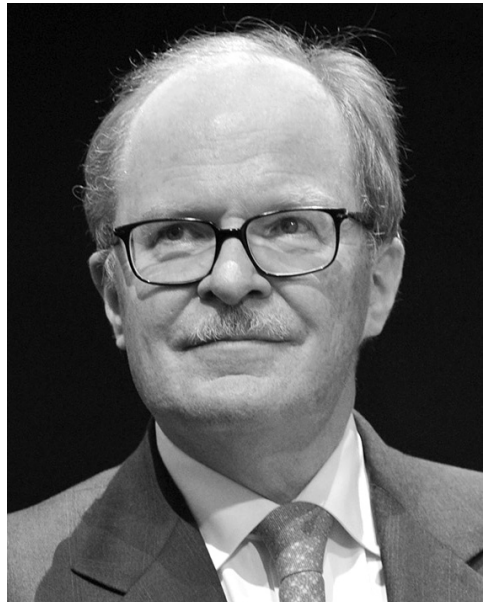

## **The Reinhold Ganz Lecture**



Reinhold Ganz has opened a new era of understanding and treatment of hip disease. As a Chair of the Department of Orthopaedics of the University of Berne he has fostered academic orthopaedic excellence and educated a generation of orthopaedic surgeons. As a Consultant at the Department of Orthopaedics of the University of Zurich from 2004 to 2007 he served as a role model for analyzing and treating orthopaedic problems and substantially contributed to the Department's development.

In recognition of his past and present contributions, «The Reinhold Ganz Lecture» was created in 2010. We are proud to invite to the 8<sup>th</sup> Reinhold Ganz Lecture.

## **Prof. em. Christian Gerber**

Christian Gerber, MD, FRCS(hon) is Professor emeritus of the Department of Orthopaedics at the University of Zürich, Switzerland. After Medical School at the Universities of Berne and Yale, he underwent medical training in Neurology, Internal Medicine, General Surgery. His orthopaedic education took place in Berne, Paris, and San Antonio. He was appointed Professor and Chairman at the Cantonal Hospital Fribourg in 1992 and at the University of Zürich for the Department of Orthopaedics in 1995. At the same time he was appointed Medical Director and Chairman of Orthopaedics at the Balgrist University Hospital, Zürich where he devoted his academic activities to shoulder surgery. He received numerous honorary memberships such as from the Western Orthopaedic Society, the Spanish Shoulder and elbow Society, the French Society of orthopaedic Surgery, Swiss Orthopaedics, the Swiss Academy of Medical Sciences and the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh and his over 400 publications have been cited over 25'000 times. He is the only four time winner oft he Charles S. Neer Award of the American Shoulder and Elbow Surgeons, the first non-American winner oft he Kappa Delta Award of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons and recipient of the Arthur Steindler Award of the Orthopaedic Research Society. In 2000 he created the ResOrtho Foundation for Orthopaedic Research and Education which has supported young academic careers. He is responsible for conception and realization of the Balgrist Campus, a unique infrastructure of national relevance for orthopaedic research and development.
